Righteousness is synonymous with justified. Justified means; to render just or innocent, free. So when we are made righteous by Christ we are free from sin. If you are laden down in sin come to Jesus for He can make you free! Jesus is giving the invitation, “Come unto me”! Matthew 11:28-30. What will be your response?

How will God reward the righteous?

Read Revelation 7:13-17.

Write the Bible Answer:

Those who have the robes of Christ righteousness and have overcome sin will be saved. **Do you want to be able to stand with this multitude that have had their robes washed in the blood of Jesus Christ?**

Write your Answer:

What must happen to us in order to be saved?

Read John 3:3; Ephesians 4:22-24; Hebrews 12:14.

Write the Bible Answer:

We must lay apart all unrighteousness and receive the words of Bible which shows us the way of salvation. The old person of sin must die, and you must be born again and live a new life in Christ. When you are born again the old habits of sin are left, and you then live a life according to the Bible, which is a life of holiness, in Jesus. Sin causes death and sin will not go to heaven, so God calls you to repent so you would not die. Let sin go! For it will only lead to death. Let it go and come to Jesus! **Be renewed by Jesus Christ!**

The Washing of Water



After a person made the sacrifice at the altar of offering what was the next thing they would come upon?

Read Exodus 40:29-30.

Write the Bible Answer:

The next thing they would come upon is the laver. In side the laver was water for washing.

Could the priest that ministered in the temple go in to the holy place dressed with what ever they wanted to wear and come in with dirty clothes?

Read Exodus 39:27; Exodus 30:20-21.

Write the Bible Answer:

They could not just come in with dirty clothes dressed with whatever they wanted to wear, but God had white linen garments for the priest, and before they could enter the holy place of the temple they had to wash their hands and feet in the laver.

Remember God had the Sanctuary to teach us lessons about salvation. What lessons does the laver spiritually teach us about salvation? What happened to us that made us need a change of raiment, and washing by Jesus?

Read Job 15:16; Isaiah 64:6.

Write the Bible Answer:

Sin has made us filthy. Without Christ, spiritually we are clothed with filthy garments. The spots on the garment represent sin and worldliness.

Do you want to be clothed with filthy garments?

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Filthy garments will eventually cause disease and death. So how can we clean the spots and make our garments clean? Can I clean it myself? Absolutely not. Bleach cannot clean it, baths can never remove it. The only One who can remove the stain of sin is Jesus Christ who has shed His blood for the sins of the world. He also cleanses us from sin and washes us spiritually with water.

What two things does Christ have?

Read 1 John 5:6.

There are two things that Christ has to wash us, water and blood. These both go together.

What is the power of the blood?

Read Ephesians 1:7; Matthew 26:28.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Remission means forgiveness. The blood of Jesus Christ liberates and removes the stain of sin from our lives.

Where is it that we learned that we must come to Christ, repent of our sins and accept the blood of Jesus which will forgive us? We are taught this at the altar of sacrifice.

What part does the water reveal?

Read Psalms 51:7; Hebrews 10:22; Ezekiel 36:25.

Write the Bible Answer:

These two, the blood and water, are revealed in 1 John 1:9. What will Jesus do for the repentant sinner?

Read 1 John 1:9.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: Someone can be forgiven but he can not continue to do the same sin, he must be cleansed. If someone was a thief but then repented and came to Christ asking for forgiveness God will forgive him, but when Christ cleanses He gives us the power to overcome stealing. He takes away the desire to continue to steal.

What does Jesus want to clothe us with?

Read Zechariah 3:3-4.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note; If we come to Christ he will take away the filthy garments of sin, and clothe you with new garments.

What is this change of raiment?

Read Isaiah 61:10; Psalms 132:16; Revelation 19:8.

Write the Bible Answer:

Note: This is the robe of righteousness and salvation. It is compared to "fine
